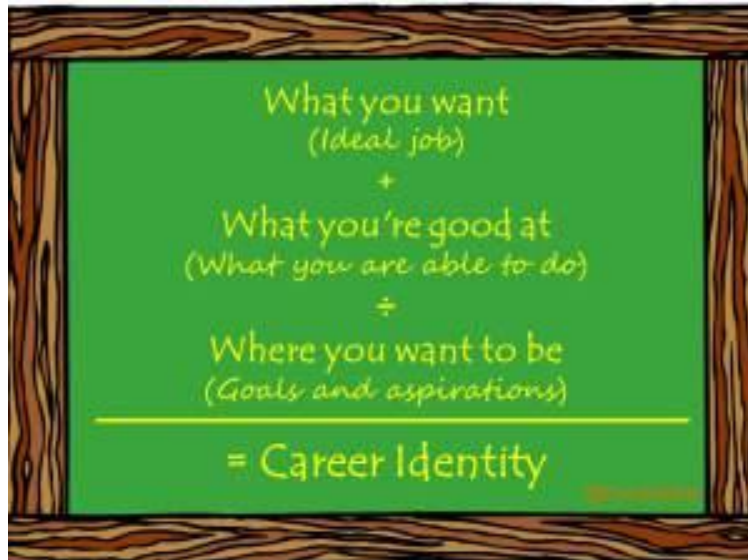


What Is Your Career Identity?
